OPERATING PROCEDURE & RISK ASSESMENTS FOR CACHALOT CHARTERS.

1. Care should be taken on embarkation & disembarkation onto the vessel. Walkways & pontoons rise & fall with the tide, Weather conditions can make them slippery
2. Only board & disembark when instructed by the skipper.
3. Take notice of the skippers safety talk.
4. All person to keep feet on deck whilst fishing, do not stand on anything to gain height. No persons allowed forward of cabin.
5. Have a general awareness of all other passengers using boat, with view to prevent any accidents. Care should be taken when using hooks & weights,& preparing bait. Instruction will be given.
6. Any incident or accident to be recorded in accident book.
7. Wear appropriate clothing for weather conditions.
8. The skipper will make any decisions to maintain the safety of the vessel & passengers.
